

Notes about this week's drought map

- No change this week. Scattered storms across the state prevented further degradation, but failed to return groundwater and soil moisture to normal levels in southeastern NC.
- Indicators such as soil moisture and streamflow suggest isolated places in the Piedmont are drying out, but have not reached D0 levels.
- Next week is forecasted to be dry and warm across the state. This pattern could lead to expanding dryness, particularly in the eastern part of the state.
